

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE REPORT – NOVEMBER 9, 2020

The Highway Committee met on October 26, 2020, and discussed the following:

Action Items:

1. The Committee reviewed a revised Municipal Winter Traffic Services Supplemental Agreement No. 3900038016A by and between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation and the Borough. This supplemental agreement revises and amends a previous agreement approved by Council at their August 10, 2020 meeting. Compensation rate to the Borough remains the same at \$1,183.73 per lane mile for snow and ice removal along SR 0322 between Market Street and Bethany Road during the 2020/2021 winter season. The total anticipated reimbursement to the Borough in 2021 also remains the same at \$14,323.13 plus any applicable adjustment to offset severe winters. The Committee will recommend that Borough Council approve the revised Municipal Winter Traffic Services Supplemental Agreement No. 3900038016A at their November 9, 2020 meeting.
2. The Committee reviewed a Resolution authorizing execution of a revised Municipal Winter Traffic Services Supplemental Agreement with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation. The Committee will recommend that Borough Council authorize the President of Borough Council and the Borough Secretary to execute the revised Municipal Winter Traffic Services Supplemental Agreement at their November 9, 2020 meeting.
3. The Committee reviewed the results of Bid #20-8 Lake Street Storm Water Improvements and will recommend that Borough Council award the bid to apparent low bidder: Iron Eagle Excavating, LLC from Highspire, PA in their total bid amount of \$76,560.00 as part of the Consent Agenda at their November 9, 2020 meeting.

Old Business Items:

1. Borough staff continues to communicate with PennDOT regarding the South Oak Street bridge pedestrian railing/vehicle barrier with regards to PennDOT's plans for replacing similar barrier on their West Main Street over Cocalico Creek bridge.

Miscellaneous Items:

1. Engineering Project Manager Burkholder updated the Committee regarding status of Comcast underground facility installation projects, both approved and those in plan review.
2. Engineering Project Manager Burkholder updated the Committee on street restoration status within the 1st block of North State Street following a recent fire hydrant lateral break in that area.
