A written examination required for the position of Police Officer with the Ephrata Police Department will take place on April 18, 2023 at the Ephrata Middle School. Registration for this exam can be completed by visiting www.policeapp.com

All applicants must have reached their twenty first (21st) birthday before the deadline for submitting completed applications. Applicants must meet the residency requirement in the current collective bargaining agreement within three (3) months of completing their probationary period.

Every applicant for any position in the police department shall possess a diploma from an accredited high school or a graduate equivalency diploma. In addition, every applicant must be a United States citizen, be physically and mentally fit to perform the full duties of a police officer, and, prior to appointment, possess a valid driver's license.

Applicants must be able to meet the minimum qualifications for certification established the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC) as set forth in 53 Pa. C.S. A. § 2161 et seq. however, applicants do not need current MPOETC certification to apply.
