Twenty-one calendar days after payment is received the Ephrata Borough's Public Works Department will automatically install the water meter in an authority approved water meter pit. If at the time of installation the water meter pit does not comply with the Ephrata Area Joint Authority Rules & Regulations, no meter will be installed and the applicant will be invoiced for a special service fee for a failed installation. Attempts to install the water meter will automatically occur at one week intervals until the meter can be installed and every unsuccessful attempt will be invoiced a special service fee. If a meter is desired prior to the 21 days please contact the Public Works Department at 717-738-9242 to schedule an appointment.
